

GSI scientists visit Russian Academy of Sciences for joint research programme

A Joint research through exchange of scientists is being carried out between Indian and Russian scientists under the banner of Integrated long term Project (ILTP). A team of Indian scientists visited to the Institute of Physics of the Earth, Russian Academy of Sciences (RAS), Moscow, under the leadership Dr. J.R. Kayal, Deputy Director General (Geophysics), Geological Survey of India (GSI), during June 7 - June 22, 2006. This team constitutes of Pankaj Mala Bhattacharya, GSI, Kolkata, Dr. Saurabh Baruah , Regional Research Laboratory (RRL), Jorhat and J.L.Gautam from Indian Metrological Department (IMD), New Delhi. There was a discussion with Prof. S.S. Arefiev, RAS, Moscow, the Russian Coordinator, regarding seismic tomography work carried out in Russia. Local Earthquake tomography was taken up using the digital seismic data of NE India for the years 2001 to 2004. Dr. J.R.Kayal made the visit to seismological observatory in Borok, Russia. Few state-of- the- art softwares for processing seismological data were also given to carry out further research in India.
